
I FOUND A BABY MAMMAL ~ NOW WHAT?



A baby's best chance for survival is its mother.



If you find a fawn:

- Mothers normally leave their babies to feed.
 - If the baby looks cold, hungry, diseased or confused (or if dogs, other animals or people threaten its safety) call a wildlife rehabilitator or park ranger.
- Otherwise leave the baby alone and leave the area. The mother will not return if people or pets are present.



If you find baby bunnies:

- damaged, it can be repaired.
 Look for a shallow
 depression lined with grass/
 fur. Place babies in nest with
 light layers of grass to hide
 them. Leave the area or the
 mother won't return.
 Mothers return only at dawn
 and dusk.
- If you find healthy bunnies that are 4-5 inches long, able to hop, with eyes open and ears up, they do not need help. They are able to survive on their own. Leave them alone. Questions? Call a wildlife rehabilitator.
